<p>Household Goods/PE Returning Citizen</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Proof of residence in B&H not older than 6 months (CIPS certificate) ▪ Certificate issued by the Bosnian embassy / consulate abroad whereby proving importer's previous and continuous stay out of B&H in a duration of minimum 12 consecutive months or minimum 12 months within a time frame of 4 years ▪ Statement by the importer of the day of his arrival date from the origin country ▪ Statement that he has never benefited from this customs privilege as per article 176 , Paragraph 4, Annex 3 of Customs Law of B&H ▪ Statement wherein customer bonds to use the personal property in the very same purpose at his place of residence in B&H ▪ Statement wherewith customer bonds to cover any customs taxes and or duties that may arise ▪ Inventory list ▪ On the special request of the customs official, proof that the personal property was in a beneficiary's possession in a period of minimum 6 months until the day of departure from the foreign country. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Statements signed by the customer must be in Bosnian language.

Household Goods/PE Foreign citizens	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Dated and valued Inventory list ▪ Official document proving that customer's common residence was elsewhere than Bosnia & Herzegovina for a period of minimum 12 months continuously ▪ Lease contract signed for a minimum period of 2 years, officially verified by Bosnian city hall authorities ▪ Residence permit issued by the Bosnian Security Ministry (Foreign Citizens Department) ▪ Statement that customer did not previously benefit from this privilege as per Article 176, Paragraph 4 and Annex 5 of Customs Law of B&H ▪ Statement saying that the goods subject to importation are used, and have belonged to the importer within the period of 6 months prior to exportation ▪ Statement confirming that this secondary residence will not be rented to a third party ▪ Statement wherewith customer bonds to cover any customs taxes and or duties that may arise. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Statements signed by the customer must be in Bosnian language.

Returning Angolan Citizens, including Diplomats, pay duties and taxes on their vehicles. Consignments including a car need an Import License regardless of their value. ▪ All containers shipped with vehicles will be transferred to FAYOL terminal where they will be inspected.
