Border Stamps in the Passport</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Export of Household goods by Sea or Road is generally straightforward in Mozambique and little difficulty is expected.</li> <li>▪ Export of Household goods by Air is controlled by a number of Authorities and is more sensitive.</li> <li>▪ Presence of the exporter in the country at the time of Export clearance is not required in Mozambique.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The Export by Air is very restricted and very controlled.                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Restrictions or prohibitions apply to the following:                                     <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Powders of any kind, Liquids of any kind, Lithium-ion batteries, Drones, Gun-shaped toys, Food, Wooden pieces of any kind, Medicine, Artwork of any kind, Items not considered Household goods, etc.</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ Please consult with your local FIDI representative.</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ Moving companies issue a Packing list after the end of the packing operation, while the (Valued) Inventory list must be drafted and signed by the owner of the goods.</li> <li>▪ Assuming all documentation has been received:                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ the Customs clearance process by Sea takes 4-5 business days after container sealing.</li> <li>▪ the Customs clearance process by Air takes 2-3 business days after Cargo submission at the Airport (Maputo).</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>Vehicles</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Customs documents for vehicle Export (Diplomats) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Letter from your Employer</li> <li>▪ Copy of your Diplomat Card issued after your arrival by MINEC</li> <li>▪ Valid Passport copy</li> <li>▪ Invoice (max. 50 KUSD for Import)</li> <li>▪ NUIT from the owner of the vehicle / Mozambique Tax Number Certificate</li> <li>▪ Modelo 75 Filled and approved by MINEC</li> <li>▪ Vehicle register cancellation certificate</li> <li>▪ License plate cancellation certificate</li> <li>▪ Interpol Police Clearance</li> </ul> </li>   <li>▪ Customs documents for vehicle import (Diplomats) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Letter from your Employer</li> <li>▪ Copy of the Customs Import process</li> <li>▪ Valid Passport copy</li> <li>▪ Invoice (max. 50 KUSD for Import)</li> <li>▪ NUIT from the owner of the vehicle / Mozambique Tax Number Certificate</li> <li>▪ Modelo 75 filled and approved by MINEC</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ In Mozambique, the Vehicle Export process requires to previously cancel the car registration and papers (license plate).</li>   <li>▪ Mozambique Road authority INATRO keeps the original documents, therefore you will not get them back after you begin the license plate cancellation process.</li>   <li>▪ License plate cancellation process is not reversible. The car will be considered as exported.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Vehicle Export is a lengthy and cumbersome process in Mozambique.</li>   <li>▪ It is recommended to start the vehicle register cancellation process well in advance in order to avoid that this process delays your move.</li>   <li>▪ Hiding vehicles in shipments through dismantling is not legal and requests of this nature will not be considered by your local FIDI representative.</li> </ul>
