<p>Removal Goods – HHG/PE</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Passport (clear copy) including the page where Oman visa is stamped. ▪ Signed Bayan Authorization ▪ Residence Card copy front and back issued by ROP (ROYAL OMAN POLICE). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 100% inspection on all shipments. ▪ Personal effects are subject to be open for inspection by custom authorities. ▪ Normal customs clearance for export takes 1-2 working days for sea and 1-2 working days for air. Fridays and Saturdays Customs will remain closed. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Oman Customs has introduced an E-Clearing system called “BAYAN”. ▪ All documents are to be electronically submitted. ▪ All personal effects and cars shipments for exports in Oman must pass this system. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The shipper has to get him/her registered at the customs; this can be done by him/her if in Oman or by their local agent who approaches DG Customs at Custom house. The authorization has to be signed manually. DG Customs will not accept electronic signature.
<p>Motor vehicles</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Passport copy. ▪ Oman visa copy. ▪ Oman Residence Card copy ▪ Valid export certificate issued by the ROP traffic department (validity of 7 days). ▪ Export number plates ▪ Singed bayan authorization 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 100% inspection 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Please note that the client will have to apply for a vehicle export certificate from the traffic department in Muscat. ▪ The ROP export certificate is valid only for 7 days, which means that the vehicle must be dispatched within 7 days of obtaining the vehicle export certificate. ▪ The Shipper on the Bill of Lading and export certificate should be the owner of the vehicle; and the name on the vehicle export
