<p>Used Household Goods/PE (sea and air) for Foreign and Thai Nationals</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Shipper's copy of passport ▪ Packing list 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Visa page not required; export can be done with any type of visa irrelevant of the assignee's employment status in Thailand. ▪ Timeline for export custom clearance is 1-3 working days. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Fine arts export permit is mandatory for the export of any types of statues or decorations representing Buddhism (and Hinduism). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Only full body images are allowed to be exported. ▪ Partial images of Buddha (head, hands, feet) are prohibited to export. ▪ All genuine antiques require back up documents with proof of origin and ownership. ▪ The genuine antique pieces may be regarded as a part of Thai national heritage and will not be allowed to export. ▪ Air shipments will be subject to security and clearing procedure. Below goods are considered dangerous and will not be allowed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Speakers, amplifiers, magnets, corrosive, flammable, explosive substances, compressed gases, spontaneously combustible, toxic, oxidising and water reactive, such as cleaning solvents. Aerosol cans, matches and firelighters, petrol products, paints, soap powders and bleaches, perfume, cologne, nail polish products and chemicals, chlorine, liquefied gas, nitrate fertiliser,

			<p>ammunition, or its components, etc.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Dry cell batteries and all Lap top Batteries need to be removed from any electronic items you intend on airfreight overseas; we highly recommend that your laptop is carried with you in your hand luggage. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Shipments are being X-rayed and failure to do so will cause potential delays and additional charges. It is the responsibility of the sender to remove all batteries from their air shipment. ▪ A VAT 7% applied to all invoiced issued in Thailand.
