Removal Goods and Vehicles	 Copy of client's passport and visa page to be provided to the destination agent Copy of inventory / PBO list if the goods are packed by the client Destination country customs forms / documents Alcohol listing / inventory Electronic items profile Service acceptance contract including clients contact details Insurance documents Any other documentation required by the destination agent. If shipping a vehicle: Vehicle registration / ownership documents Vehicle purchase invoice Vehicle Odometer reading Client's declaration if the vehicle can be shipped DG / NON DG with authorisation for disconnection of battery and draining the fuel etc. 		There are no particular export clearance requirements for used household goods and vehicles in New Zealand except that the client is required to provide the listed documents.
