<p>Vehicles and motor-bikes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Export letter from employer ▪ Passport copy ▪ Packing list ▪ TIN and password issued by Uganda Revenue Authority password ▪ Deregistration certificate for the vehicle 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ VIN/ Chassis number and engine number are required for customs clearance. ▪ Customs require a separate inventory for electronics with serial numbers, make/model and TV size in inches. ▪ All non-diplomatic shipments are verified 100% by customs ▪ All items owned for less than one year, food items and alcoholic beverages are subject to taxes and duties. ▪ Ammunitions, fire arms, pornography, toy guns, drones, more than 2 used fridges and computers or TVs are all prohibited. ▪ All non-diplomatic shipments are subjected to UNBS (National Bureau of Standards) inspection prior to release at a fee of USD 235.00/shipment ▪ All used vehicles for diplomats or non-diplomats must undergo UNBS inspection at USD 141.00/vehicle if not pre-inspected at origin ▪ All non-diplomats must attend a physical customs interview when the shipment arrives in Kampala/Entebbe airport. ▪ Importer/shipper must be in the country for
