<p>Removal goods</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Copy of valid passport. ▪ Original valued inventory in French dated and signed by the shipper. ▪ Change of residence certificate (available from city hall from city of departure). ▪ Invoice for all electrical items less than 6 months old. ▪ letter from the employer explaining the client is left the country ▪ Non-sale certificate (declaration on the honour that client will not sell his personal effects). ▪ BIETC (Bordereau d'Identification de Cargaison). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Export of African artwork is subject of “autorisation exportation d’objet d’art” establish by Culture Ministry. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ There is a tax on all exported items of 3 to 4% of CIF value (RUSID Tax). ▪ All shippers are to pay this tax, even diplomats.
