GOODS	DOCUMENTS REQUIRED	CUSTOMS PRESCRIPTIONS	REMARKS
Used HHG/PE	<ul> <li>Two clear negotiable original bills of lading</li> <li>A copy of the inventory in English (and a separate inventory for electronics with sizes and model specified)</li> <li>A valid work permit and letter of employment.</li> <li>PVoC certificate</li> <li>The consignee's original passport (NOT a copy)</li> <li>A copy of the job appointment letter</li> <li>The consignees copy of the employment contract</li> <li>Tax Identification Number</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Shipper must be in the country before arrival of shipment to avoid storage/demurrage charges.</li> <li>Diplomatic missions request their waivers direct from customs.</li> <li>Diplomatic shipments require special services, notify our office prior to dispatching diplomatic goods.</li> <li>Customs clearance takes 3 to 4 working days for airfreight shipments and 7-10 working days for sea freight.</li> <li>Goods should be used.</li> <li>Customs verifies all non-diplomatic shipments</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>More than one litre of alcohol will attract a duty of 119% per litre.</li> <li>TIN: Tax Identification Number.</li> </ul>
Pets	<ul> <li>Original export permit from the country of origin.</li> <li>Original international health certificate (to be attached to the kennel).</li> <li>Original AWB</li> <li>The original owner's passport (therefore the owner has to be in Uganda).</li> <li>Proof of employment abroad.</li> <li>Original vaccination cards.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Copies of the international health certificate and export permit within 7 days of arrival of the dog in Uganda.</li> <li>Import permit is only valid for 3 months from date of issue.</li> <li>No inspection.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Origin agent must ensure booking pets on daytime arrivals.</li> </ul>
Vehicles	<ul> <li>A valid work permit</li> <li>The consignee's original passport (NOT a copy)</li> <li>BL/AWB</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Old vehicles should not exceed 11 years.</li> <li>Takes 3 to 4 days and 10-15 working days for registration of vehicle.</li> <li>Shipment must inspected at origin.</li> </ul>	TIN: Tax Identification Number.
