Household Goods/PE	 Copy of valid passport Copy of valued inventory in French, dated and signed by the shipper Dated and signed copy of the Washington Convention Invoice for all electrical appliances less than 6 months old Resident/work permit or letter from the employer stating that the assignee is starting a new contract in Chad Non-sale certificate (sworn declaration that the client will not sell his personal effects in Chad) Change of residence certificate from the city hall of the current city of residence or from the consulate of their country of origin for expatriates. 		 All documents must be sent to the moving company at least 4 days before the arrival of the shipment, in order to apply for and be granted duty-free clearance. Non-diplomatic shipments will be subject to a 2% "Statistical Tax", based on the CIF inventory value. Household goods shipments without an exemption or a change of residence certificate are subject to a 70% customs tax, based on the CIF inventory value. Please note that all shipments are opened and checked by customs. Important: the certificate of removal is compulsory, including for diplomats and NGO members. If this document is not provided, the effects will be taxed (70%).

Taxes on motor vehicles will depend on age, engine, etc. (approximately 61% of CIF value). You must provide official documentation showing the engine number and engine capacity, car registration document, and/or registration certificate.
