RESTRICTED ITEMS	 Hazardous items: Perishables. Batteries. Please remove from all items, especially laptops. Open containers and bottled bleaches. Paints, thinners, chemicals, weed killers. Insecticides, other poisons, aerosol. Spray cans. Ammunition, flares, fireworks gasoline, oil, kerosene, lighter fluid or other 	 Local Customs or Law may prohibit the following items: Food Stuffs & Spices – including food flavorings containing alcohol. In case the assignee still wants to ship then he/she has to take prior approval from the Ministry of Defence, Ministry of External Affairs and the Directorate General of Foreign Trade before shipping the goods.
