RESTRICTED ITEMS		<ul> <li>Prohibited items:</li> <li>Food Stuffs &amp; Spices – including food flavorings containing alcohol</li> <li>Films, Videos, and DVD's, CD's (Compact Disc), Vinyl records</li> <li>May be confiscated and viewed to verify content – PG13 or R rated movies may be considered culturally offensive.</li> <li>Adult Literature – any books, videos, CDs, software, films or other media that might</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Drone export in any form is restricted and comes under the list of restricted goods.</li> <li>If the assignee still wants to ship then he/she has to take prior approval from the Ministry of Defence, Ministry of External Affairs and the Directorate General of Foreign Trade before shipping the goods.</li> <li>Contact your local agent for up to date list of restricted and prohibited items.</li> </ul>
