Removal Goods - HHG/PE	 Copy of valid passport or extension issued by Venezuelan officer by the moment of the operation – all pages including blank ones. Copy of ID (CEDULA DE IDENTIDAD) – valid. Copy of the updated Shipper RIF (Fiscal Information Registry). Document Descriptive Inventory contents listed. Work letter from employer when the client is relocated. 2 original and copies OBLs/AWB. Shipper's signature and fingerprints on Customs forms. For both modalities Air/Ocean: notarization of a power of attorney. Except for Diplomatic Shipments: Power of attorney just authorized by customs authorities instead of 'notarization'. Institute of Cultural Heritage (IPC) certification for Art work. 	 Exportation is free of duties and taxes only if the Customs official is satisfied that the contents are used household goods. The Customs officer and the National Guard will carefully inspect most shipments. For all shipments may apply: Council tax 0.12% CIF value Port Access Social Fee (n/a) just for inbound Elevator Port/airport Handling Containers Disinfection Fee (n/a) just for inbound Other charges depending on the shipping line. 	 Used Household Goods, including furniture, electrical appliances fall into this category. Customs clearance is rigorous and demanding. All shipments should be inspected in customs. The presence of the owner of the move at the moment of inspection is mandatory. Otherwise, there must be a representative duly authorized by Notarized Power of Attorney to represent the owner.
